### **How Did The Day of The Lord's Resurrection Come To Be Called Easter?**

The United States is one of the English-speaking countries of the world that calls this day "Easter." In most other countries it is known by some variation of the Hebrew word for Passover ("Pesach"), such as "Pasch." Several theories have been offered as to the source for our use of Easter. One theory is that name "Easter" was borrowed from the name of an Anglo-Saxon spring goddess, Eostre. But there is little proof for the existence of this goddess. The most widely accepted view is that Easter has a Northern European origin, coming from the Old High German for dawn, *eostarun*. Christ rose in glory from the dead on Easter Sunday morning like the morning star, the sun that rises in the east.
