Through the *With Grateful Hearts* campaign, our parish will receive 25% of all funds collected up to our goal of \$380,000.00. As a result children from these needy families will be returning to public school this year without necessary school supplies. Our church is collecting school supplies to provide local schools with resources that these children can draw upon during the school year. In the past our parish has donated up to \$700 and 500 pounds of supplies. Please help if you can.
