CHRIST IS RISEN!

Truly, JESUS is Lord and Savior of all. Through his passion and death on the cross, Jesus liberated sinners from their alienation from God and one another. In his resurrection, Jesus has liberated all of humankind from sin, from death and from hopelessness.

At the end of our Easter services, the Young Adult Ministry is conducting egg hunt among our Rel. Ed. children. The egg shows new life. New life comes forth when the chick breaks out of the egg. The egg is likened to the tomb in which Jesus was buried. The chick breaking forth from the egg reminds us of Jesus breaking forth from the tomb.

We joyfully acclaim "Alleluia" to express the highest level of praise and joy in the rising of Christ from the dead. In the words of St. Augustine, "We are an Easter people and Alleluia is our song."

The Resurrection is not just about Jesus. He is the first, the pioneer, the older brother who opens up for all of us the possibility of life beyond the grave. Because of this great gift that is ours in the risen Christ, we also are to live as already risen beings. It is the resurrection of Jesus and our dying and rising with him to new spiritual life that should impel us to help roll back the stones of tombs that keep anyone captive and in the dark. As we move through the Easter season, let us be true to the risen Christ who lives and moves among us, giving meaning and purpose to every aspect of our lives, in good times and in bad, in suffering and in celebration. ⦿ ⦿ ⦿
