Capital Campaign Rebate

Through the *With Grateful Hearts* campaign, our parish will receive 25% of all funds collected up to our goal of \$380,000.00. After achieving this goal, OLS will receive 50% of additional funds raised up to 150% of our goal. We have now received our second rebate from our parishioners' pledges. To date, on pledges totaling approximately \$847,468.00, the amount of \$33,250.63 has been collected over the last quarter. 25% of this has now been returned to our parish and I have received a check this week for \$8,313.00. These new monies will be directed toward Repair and Maintenance of Facilities, Youth Ministry and Leadership Formation. Thank you to everyone who has contributed and made this possible.
