In the US, when Feb. 2<sup>nd</sup> is not on a Sunday, the celebration is on the Sunday after the Presentation – Feb. 6.

Bishop Larry Silva will be presiding at a special Mass on Saturday, February 5, 10:30am at Newman Center on the UH-Manoa campus. In addition to helping parishioners reflect on the role of consecrated life within the Christian community, the World Day for Consecrated Life is an opportunity to give thanks to God for calling forth men and women dedicated to a life of prayer and service and consecrated to live within a religious community.
