What is Ordinary Time?

The word "ordinary" in popular usage may describe things that are commonplace or even dull. The word "ordinary" in Ordinary Time has a different meaning, that of regular, typical or standard. Ordinary time is the longest liturgical season in the Catholic Church, but it is broken into two periods. The first period runs from the day after the Baptism of the Lord until the day before Ash Wednesday. This portion of Ordinary Time focuses on the childhood of Jesus and his public ministry. The second period of Ordinary Time lasts from the day after Pentecost through the final day before Advent and focuses on Christ's reign. Ordinary Time can also be thought of as the parts of the Church year when we are not in the Advent, Christmas, Lent, or Easter seasons. The color of ordinary time is green, which signifies life and growth.
