Pope Benedict XVI's Encyclical: "In Hope We Were Saved"

In discussing the meaning of life in his encyclical, Pope Benedict mentions how Christ is often depicted as a philosopher on ancient roman sarcophagi, or stone coffins. At that time philosopher was someone who knew how to teach the essential art of being authentically human—the art of living and dying. For example, toward the end of the third century on the sarcophagus of a child in Rome is found the figure of Christ holding the Gospel in one hand and the philosopher's traveling staff in the other. Pope Benedict explains, "With his staff, he conquers death; the Gospel brings the truth that itinerant philosophers had searched for in vain. In this image, which then became a common feature of sarcophagus art for a long time, we see clearly what both educated and simple people found in Christ: he tells us who man truly is and what a man must do in order to be truly human. He shows us the way, and this way is the truth. He himself is both the way and the truth, and therefore, he is also the life which all of us are seeking. He also shows us the way beyond death; only someone able to do this is a true teacher of life.
