### **Rental of School Classrooms**

A non-profit organization called Waianae Coast Early Childhood Services will be leasing two of the classrooms at our school. Douglas Mersberg, Executive Director of the agency, gave a presentation to our parish leaders which included members of the Pastoral Council, Finance Committee, Liturgy Committee and Building & Maintenance Committee. The parish leaders present unanimously approved the leasing of the classrooms. The Waianae Coast Early Childhood Services is a community-based agency that provides early intervention services to special needs children from 0 through 3 years of age that have developmental delays in cognitive, physical, communication, social, or mental growth. The staff and personnel provide individual family service plans, therapy services such as speech/language pathology, occupational therapy, physical therapy, special education and developmental evaluations. The State of Hawaii has recently contracted with this agency to be the only provider of early intervention services in the Wahiawa, Haleiwa, Waialua and North Shore area. The agency currently operates two preschools, a feeding kitchen, and two early intervention programs, one in Waianae and the other in Waipahu.
