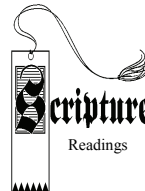

A custom followed in many places is wearing new clothes at Easter. This practice can be traced to the new, white robes that clothed the newly baptized at ancient Easter Vigils. New clothes symbolize the new life of baptism and the glorious new life of Jesus Christ upon his resurrection. During the Middle Ages in Europe, after Easter Mass people would stroll outside the church in their new clothes walking behind a crucifix. This evolved into our country's Easter parades, especially in New York City on Fifth Avenue.
