Why is Water Used So Prominently Throughout Easter?

Easter celebrates Christ's resurrection to new life. The baptismal water displayed at the front of our church recognizes the rising to new life of those newly baptized at the Easter Vigil. The water also recalls our own baptism when we were raised to new life in Christ. When our pastor blessed the baptismal water during the Easter Vigil Mass, he said: "By the power of the Holy Spirit give to this water the grace of your Son, so that in the sacrament of baptism all those whom you have created in your likeness may be cleansed from sin and rise to a new birth of innocence by the water and the Holy Spirit." The sprinkling rite performed throughout the Sundays of Easter reminds us of our need to be continually re-born through the Holy Spirit into more perfect life in Christ.
