How the Divine Mercy will use justice with souls can be summed up in these messages He gave to St. Faustina:

"...My daughter, speak to the world about My mercy. Let all mankind recognize My unfathomable mercy. It is a sign for the end times, after it will come (230) the day of justice. While there is still time, let them have recourse to the fount of My mercy; let them profit from the Blood and Water which gushed forth for them..." (422-423) "...Souls that appeal to My mercy delight Me. To such souls I grant even more graces than they ask...Before I come as a just judge, I first open wide the door of My mercy. *He who refuses to pass through the door of my mercy must pass through the door of my justice.*" (420)
