

## YEAR FOR PRIESTS 2009-2010

### *The Priesthood Today—We're All in This Together*

The interesting development of accepting married Episcopal priests into the Roman rite, and the presence of married clergy in Eastern-rite Catholic churches, may prompt people to think in a new way about some of these questions.

Let me say that I believe that the most difficult job in the hierarchical Church today is that of parish priest. Think of the tireless work of St. John Vianney, the patron of parish priests (see box on p. 3). I have unbounded respect for priests who are on call 24/7. They labor with one half to one quarter the staff that they had 40 years ago. They are responsible for Baptisms, weddings, funerals, as well as Masses, as well as administrative functions, as well as confessions, as well as having to drop everything and counsel someone in crisis, or visit people in the hospital whenever someone falls ill—emergencies never come on a schedule.

In our hierarchical Church, I know few people who work as hard as parish priests do. (In the secular world, I would compare them to the on-call schedules of parents of young children.) The responsibility of being on call constantly is something that some people may not know or appreciate about parish priests. Parish priests can hardly say no to visiting the hospital, celebrating a funeral Mass or many other of their duties.
