## DIOCESAN CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

We are pleased to announce that we have received our third quarterly disbursement of 2011 from the *With Grateful Hearts* Capital Campaign of the Diocese. From the generosity of dear parishioners **\$27,210.14** has been collected over the last quarter and I received a check this week for **\$7,380.64**, which is 25% of that amount. As of September 2011 OLS parishioners have now contributed a total of \$339,941.84 and, including this disbursement, our parish has now received a total of \$84,985.46.
