The Novena prayers for St. Lorenzo de Ruiz is scheduled for September 19 to 27, Saturday to Sunday at the Parish Hall at 5:00 PM. There will be a Mass in honor of the saint on Sunday, September 27 at the 5:00 PM Ilocano Mass and on his Feast day, Monday, September 28, 2009 at 7:00 AM.
