Pastoral Council News

The Parish Pastoral Council will be accepting nominations for membership on the council during the weekend of September 6th & 7th. The council is looking to fill seven (7) outgoing positions. Five (5) of the positions are to be filled by an adult parishioner and two (2) positions are to be filled by a youth parishioner under the age of 18.

The criteria in order to be nominated are that a nominee must be a baptized member of the Catholic Church and a member of the parish. In addition, members should be an individual of prayer, an individual with a sense of mission and an individual with talents or skills to bring to the council. The term of the office is for three (3) years. Meetings are held once a month.
