FEAST OF SAN LORENZO RUIZ

THE FILIPINO PROTOMARTYR

Every *September 28*, the Church commemorates 16 saints who were martyred in Nagasaki, Japan, during the years 1633-1637. They included 9 Japanese, 4 Spaniards, 1 Frenchman, 1 Italian and 1 Filipino who were Dominican friars and tertiaries. The Filipino martyr was *Lawrence Ruiz*, the father of a family, a sacristan and catechist. Due to their faith in Christ they suffered horrible tortures, their bodies burned by order of the ruler, Tokugawa Yemitsu. They were canonized in October 18, 1987.

Novena prayers and rosary are offered from Sept. 19-27, 5pm in Church. The Filipino community will honor him on Sunday, 5pm, at the Ilocano Mass with a procession of his statue donated by the *Ferido family*.

WHAT IS RCIA?

The **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)** is a process not a program. It is the process through which interested adults and older children are gradually introduced to the Roman Catholic faith and way of life.

The RCIA is a communal process and involves a number of stages punctuated by [liturgical rites](#) to aid and assist the potential [convert](#) toward the final rite, usually at the [Easter Vigil](#) at which time they will become full members of the Catholic Church. The entire process takes several months, (ideally a minimum of one complete liturgical year), but participants are generally invited to proceed at a pace which suits them individually.

A [catechumen](#) is a person who has never received [baptism](#). A candidate is a person who was already baptized. The Catholic Church acknowledges other Christian baptisms as long as the [Trinitarian formula](#) "in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit" and flowing water was used.

THE SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

The sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist mark full initiation into the Catholic faith. If you are baptized, 18 years of age or older, and you want to receive the sacrament of *Confirmation*, or, *First Communion*, please call 621-5109, ext. 226.

GUIDELINES ON MASS INTENTIONS

1. Only **one (1) family's** intention is accepted **per Mass**. A family may request an intention for 1 (one) or 2 (two) persons per Mass. The stipend is \$10.00.

2. The *Friday morning Mass at 7am* and *Sunday 7am Mass* have been designated for **collective Mass intentions** in which several families may offer **one (1) intention** each.

3. A Mass intention for the *Saturday evening Mass* must be the actual death anniversary or birthday or wedding anniversary.
