MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Today, February 1, 2015, we officially launch the Forward in Faith Capital Campaign to raise money to build our new parish hall and to do improvements in our Church.

Our goal is to raise \$1.5 million. It seems like a lot and it is. OLS has been planning the new hall (with new bathrooms!) for years. The talking and planning phase is over.
