**MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD**

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This Sunday's Gospel gives our whole program for Lent. During Lent we journey toward Easter, the celebration of the death and resurrection of Jesus. It's also the celebration of our death and resurrection in Baptism when we ceased to be just ourselves and we became Christ-people, Christians. We no longer live ourselves but Christ lives through us and in us.

As we begin to prepare for Easter, this first Sunday of Lent reminds us of Jesus temptation so that we can face our own temptations to sin. The Devil is continually trying to get us away from the way of the Lord, the way to Easter. Only fools think he's not.

The angels ministered to Jesus in his temptation. God doesn't forget us. He's with us each step of the way because he wants to have his way in our lives. His way is abundant life here and eternal life forever. Jesus comes preaching the "Kingdom of God". He wants us to be part of it and so he tells us we have to repent, put sin aside, turn from what is not of God in our lives and accept God's way, his Kingdom. Let us pray for each other during Lent, that we can resist sin and open ourselves to Jesus' Kingdom.

### Adult Bible Study – “Mark-Getting to Know Jesus”

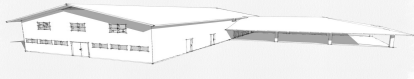

## New Parish Hall & OLS Capital Campaign

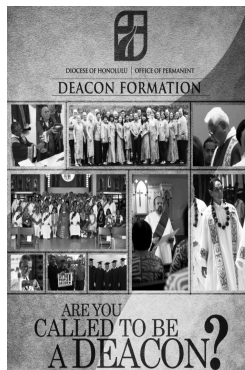
