The Mystery of the Cross

Why did Jesus die? What is the meaning behind Jesus' passion and death? If these are questions you think you already have a handle on, that you have a pretty good understanding of today's Gospel, think again.

The Cross is one of the central mysteries of the Christian faith. To say it is a mystery means that whatever you think you know about the Cross is more untrue than true. Whatever you understand is a small tip of a very large iceberg, indeed, a molecule compared to the universe.

To be reminded of this is not meant to discourage us. Quite the opposite. The things we understand are easily set aside and dismissed. When we “get” something, it is then beneath us, something we can control and even manipulate. But mysteries? Mysteries can only be experienced, felt, touched, entered into. This week in particular, this most Holy Week, spend some time with Jesus, experiencing anew His mystery.
