MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

This Sunday's Gospel is one of the more interesting encounters between Jesus and someone he meets along the way. Up until this point Jesus has been preaching the Kingdom of God to his fellow Jews. He even says, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." Along comes the Canaanite woman, a member of a people that were traditional enemies of the Jews, and she helps him expand the horizon of his mission. They spar with words and Jesus even could be seen to be a bit harsh, referring to non-Jews as "dogs." The woman, not to be put off, humbly answers back speaking of the little dogs that eat scraps that fall from the masters table. In the end Jesus recognizes the pagan woman's "great faith" and he heals her daughter.

When I was a young priest I made a Cursillo retreat. On the back of the cross we received at the end of the weekend were the words "Jesus is counting on you." Like Jesus counted on the Canaanite woman to expand the horizon of his mission, He is counting on us. In the 16th century the great St. Teresa of Avila wrote,

*"Christ has no body but yours,
No hands, no feet on earth but yours,
Yours are the eyes with which he looks
Compassion on this world,
Yours are the feet with which he walks to do good,
Yours are the hands, with which he blesses all the world.
Yours are the hands, yours are the feet,
Yours are the eyes, you are his body.
Christ has no body now but yours,
No hands, no feet on earth but yours,
Yours are the eyes with which he looks compassion on this world.
Christ has no body now on earth but yours."*

We are the Body of Christ, filled with his Spirit. We, OLS, are Jesus' presence here in Wahiawa. He is depending on us to reach out in his name and welcome our inactive brothers and sisters to this their family home. Today after the homily take a card and write down names and then offer them to the Lord in the collection basket. It's a simple gesture of love. The Lord will do great things with it.
