MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Our parish community is going to experience another change after Easter. Father Yanto will be leaving Our Lady of Sorrows. He has been assigned by his Superior in Indonesia to go to Rome for graduate studies in theology.

When he told me a while back, it did not come as a great surprise. I thought that the "higher ups" had this in mind and that he would only be here for a short while. I just didn't think it would be this short!

Fr. Yanto's combination of a balanced personality, serious spirituality and intellectual ability recommends him for higher study. I imagine that the plan is that he teach in the seminary and form future generations of ss.cc. in Indonesia.

We will have a farewell celebration for him on Saturday evening, April 26, after the 5:00 PM Mass. He will leave for Indonesia around April 30 for a visit with his family and the ss.cc. community. At the beginning of June he will go to Rome to begin studying Italian in preparation for studies at the Gregorian University, which begin in October.

There will not be anyone replacing him as Parochial Vicar. Eventually there may be an ss.cc. in residence, who will be able to help with Masses as needed. Another possibility would be sharing a parochial vicar with St. Michael's. We will have to wait a while before anything is decided in that regard.

About Those Mountaintop Experiences...

Whether it happens this Lent or sometime down the road, if you follow Jesus, if you respond to God's nudges in your life, you almost certainly WILL have one or more mountaintop experiences like the disciples in today's Gospel. Have you had one of these – a time you were super close to God, experiencing God in all of God's goodness?

Here are a couple of things to keep in mind about these delicious "mountaintop" experiences: First, we can't predict or control it. We cannot make ourselves "feel" close to God. Jesus has to invite us and then take us up the mountain.

Second, when we first feel close to God, we might be tempted to respond like Peter, hoping the moment will never end. Note that God does not want us to "make a tent," to try to make the moment last.

And the moment will end. Like the disciples, we too will have to leave, to walk down the mountain and go back to our everyday lives. But when we do, Jesus will almost certainly be walking with us.
