# FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

## MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today is the fourth Sunday of the Easter season. The Gospel for this Sunday is always taken from the tenth chapter of where Jesus identifies himself as "the Good Shepherd." "Good Shepherd Sunday" is designated by the Church as the day of prayer for vocations.

We receive our first vocation in our baptism. The vocation of every one of us, who are Church, is to live as followers of Jesus Christ, to bring him to those around us and to live forever with him in heaven. Within that vocation, common to all of us, the Lord calls each of us to live in a certain way. As someone comes to adulthood and even well on in years, a Christian listens to the Lord to hear what form of Life the Lord is calling him/her to. For many this is a call to marriage, to be a sign of God's faithful love by life-long commitment to another person and to cooperate with God the creator in bringing forth children.

On this day of prayer for vocations we pray especially for vocations to the priesthood and consecrated religious life. We have a young man from our parish studying for the priesthood, Frankie Villanueva. Deacon Dino's son, Romple Emwalu, is also studying for the priesthood. This is a great blessing and we should pray for Frankie and Romple.

We also pray that the Lord will call other young men to answer a call to the priesthood, either in the Diocese of Honolulu or in a religious community such as mine, the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts.

We pray too that young women will hear the call to be a religious sister. A consecrated woman, whatever work she does or as a nun dedicated to contemplation, reminds us how much God loves his Church. The essence of her vowed life is her loving relationship with Jesus, the Church's one spouse.

Often we hear "there are no vocations" but there are. And if any member of our parish (young or not so young) is hearing the call, however faintly, please come to see me and I will show you some places you might want to look.

## Easter Season Activities for Families

### 6 Fresh Ideas for Mealtime Prayer

If you find prayer becoming habit over heart, there are ways to be more mindful at mealtime. Here are a few different approaches to spicing up the prayer portion of your family meals.



- \* Have family members take turns leading the prayer each day. You might start with a petition, praise to God—whatever the leader chooses.
- \* Sing the traditional prayer—let your child improvise the melody.
- \* Institute a moment of silence. St. Thérèse of Lisieux described prayer as “a simple look turned toward heaven.”
- \* Ask each member to say one thing he or she is grateful for that day.
- \* Expand on the previous exercise by having each person at the table quickly answer these questions: What are you grateful for? What do you want to ask God for? What are you sorry for today? Whom did you help?
- \* Read a poem or Scripture passage that gives thanks to God. Perhaps you can even find positive lyrics in a song from pop culture to engage your children.
