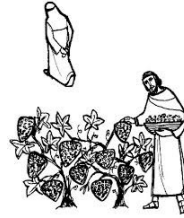

MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

In our sanctuary to the right of the crucifix there is a statue of a young man looking up toward heaven. That is Saint Lorenzo Ruiz, the first Filipino Saint. His feast day is this Sunday, September 28. When Pope John Paul canonized him in 1987, he called him "the most improbable of saints."

The son of a Chinese father and a Filipino mother, he grew up just outside Manila. He married a local woman with whom he had two sons and a daughter. They were members of the Dominican fathers' parish in Manila. As he had beautiful handwriting, he worked for the Dominicans as a calligrapher, transcribing official records of Baptism and the other sacraments.

In 1636 Lorenzo was unjustly accused of being involved in a murder. The Dominicans helped him escape by having him join a mission band going to another country to spread the Gospel. Lorenzo thought they were going to Taiwan where his Chinese heritage would have been a help. Instead the group went to Nagasaki in Japan. However they were unable to evangelize as when they arrived there, the Christians were suffering a great persecution. Lorenzo and his fifteen companions were immediately arrested and tortured horribly before being killed. When his persecutors offered, "Deny your faith and we will spare your life." Lorenzo replied, "I will never do it. I am a Catholic and happy to die for God. If I have a thousand lives to offer, I will offer them to God." He died for Jesus Christ on September 29, 1627.

A husband and father, falsely accused of a crime, and because of that a missionary, who never got to really be one but instead became a martyr, courageously dying for Jesus Christ and the Gospel...yes "the most improbable of saints." Lord in all the ups and downs, ins and outs of each of our lives, make us improbable saints.
