### MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

At all the Masses this weekend we will have an opportunity to make an offering to the Lord of our time and talent for the next year. 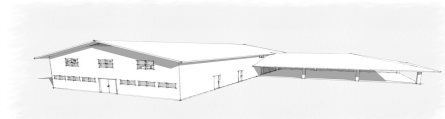
