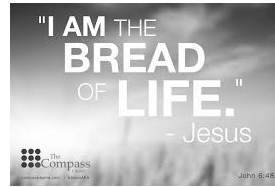

MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

Last weekend Sister Marykuty M.S.M.H.C. and Sister Malia Dominica O.P. of the Diocesan Vocation Office spoke to us of the gift of religious life. They reminded us that we are all consecrated in Baptism and that we have all received gifts from God. We are called to be stewards, to cherish the gifts God gives us and to return them to him in thanksgiving by using them in service for others.

This weekend we welcome Father Raja Selvam of the Diocese of Sivagangai in India, who will speak to us of his diocese's work with orphans and schools for the poor. God has given us the gift of financial resources. Father Raja is going to ask us to be good stewards of our money by giving some of it to help his work with poor children. Father will be accompanied by Bishop Susaimanickan of Sivagangai. We are happy that they will be with us to give us an opportunity to exercise stewardship by participating in the mission of their diocese, so far away but so close in Jesus Christ.

Every week we publish the record of our parish's financial stewardship. Thank you so much for your generosity. Thank you especially for all those who have contributed to our Forward in Faith Campaign. We have collected almost half a million dollars in gifts and pledges. That added to the \$300,000 already in our building fund means we are over half way to our goal.

On August 19 we will have the first meeting of our Parish Pastoral Council for the year. We recently had a discernment process to call four new members to serve on the council. As a result of that process I have appointed Anita Sasaki, Matthew Bugher, Valerie Dascil-Tago and David Monroy to three year terms on the PCC. These four brothers and sisters have varied gifts given them by God. They will steward those gifts by service on our PCC and we are thankful.

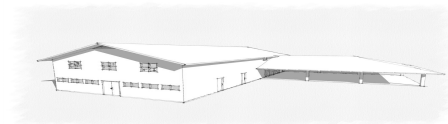
