MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Every Friday evening during Lent we gather for the Way of the Cross. This past Friday we had the beautiful presentation of the “living stations” by our youth and young adults. In a world that wants the young to be successful and to achieve their dreams, our young brothers and sisters act out the story of a man rejected by his own people, betrayed by some of his closest followers and handed over to execution by the secular power.

On the surface, Jesus of Nazareth sounds like a colossal failure but that’s only what seems to be “on the surface”. In this Sunday’s Gospel Jesus speaks of himself as a seed planted in order to bear fruit. “Amen, amen, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat; but if it dies, it produces much fruit.” The seed is meant to be planted. Jesus is meant to die. Only by his dying, do we really live. In his seeming failure is hidden not just success but total victory, his and ours. Even death is overcome!

This Sunday we begin the last two weeks of Lent and the Liturgy takes on a different tone. The Gospel readings (Sunday and daily) all point to Jesus coming arrest and crucifixion. Jesus says in the Gospel “The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified.” Now is the hour. It has finally arrived. There is no turning back. Jesus will be lifted up on the cross and lifted up from the tomb. His glory is our glory. From now until Easter we have two weeks to celebrate Jesus’ “hour”.

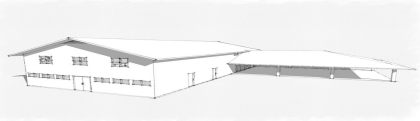
