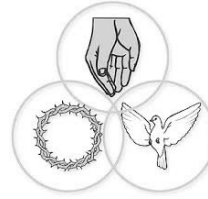

MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

This weekend is Trinity Sunday. The Scripture readings speak beautifully of this central tenet of our Catholic faith.

It would be tempting to try to "explain" the mystery, but in the course of history much smarter folks than I have tried to do that and ended up in heresy. So I won't go there. It helps me appreciate the Trinity by thinking of how I experience this one God in three persons.

God is for us. He's not a God we have to do all kinds of things for, so that we remain in his good graces. His good grace, his love and mercy for us, is where it all starts.

God is our Father. We come forth from his creative hand. The world is wonderful because it reflects his infinite beauty. Each human being is sacred: the smallest unseen human, just a few cells in his/her mother's womb as well as the older person unable to communicate much due to Alzheimer's and everyone in between.

As beloved of God we can still mess up and seriously so. Our sin and cooperation with the "prince of this world" is our greatest source of suffering. We suffer because we deny the creator and his will written in our conscience. However he does not abandon us to the hardness of our heart, he comes among us. He becomes one of us and saves us in Jesus. The Son of God is always there to free us, offering us the freedom of his mercy.

God saves us and goes a step farther. In his Spirit, he dwells within us and he connects us to all those in whom he dwells. The followers of Jesus become his body in the world. We communicate his life and holiness to one another and we go to others with Word of this great loving God, this God for us.

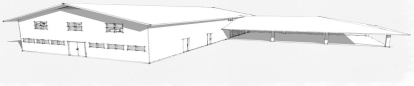

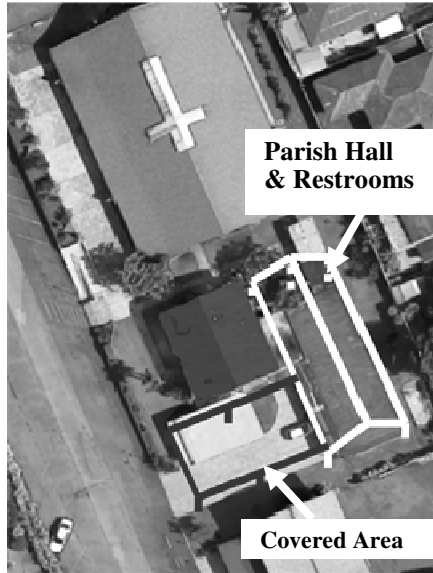
