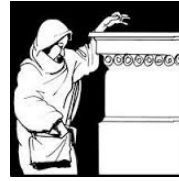

MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

As we get into November the year is waning and in colder climes winter is here and nature seems to die as darkness and frigid temperatures set in. In November the Church's year is coming to a close and the liturgy speaks of end things, the end of life, the end of the world, judgement and what comes after.

This week we hear in the letter to the Hebrews that, "it is appointed that human beings die once and after this the judgement..." It's a pretty stark statement. "It is appointed..." There's no getting around it. Death comes to all of us. For some it comes after a long life, sometimes a very long one. One of our Sacred Hearts sisters in France just died at 106! Then there are the young who die before their time, before they have not realized their dreams or even had time to put their dreams into words. Some folks are given time to prepare for death. They bid farewell to family and friends. They are visited by the priest who brings the consolation of the sacraments, including a final confession. Then there are those who die unexpectedly. Think of all those people on the plane that crashed in Egypt. If they weren't prepared to meet the Lord before they boarded, it was probably too late.

Yes, as Hebrews tells us, after death comes judgement. We stand before the Lord, the Lord who has consecrated us in Baptism, fed us with his Body and Blood. The Lord, who has given us every opportunity and help to prepare for death and did we take it? Hebrews tells us that Jesus Christ "appeared to take away sin by his sacrifice", his gift of himself on the cross. This is how much he wanted to share eternity with us. He gave himself. When we die somehow the Lord will examine us to see if we did our part, if we opened ourselves to the salvation that he has been offering us all along.

So many things in life are uncertain but not death and judgement. The consolation of our faith is that we will be judged not by the "grim reaper" but by the merciful Lord who stands "before God on our behalf."

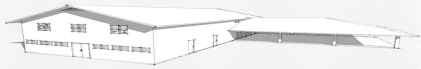


WAHIAWA SANTA PARADE
