MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

“Every life is worth living” is the theme of October 2015, Respect Life Month. Hillary Clinton once wrote a book entitled “It Takes a Village”. I believe her point was that it takes a village to raise a child. There may be something to that but in reality even without a whole village, a family is more than sufficient.

Family is important not just for raising a child but as a place of welcome, nourishment and growth for us at all stages of life. As a vowed religious, I don't have my own family. However I am part of a religious community and I could not imagine living my vocation without my ss.cc. brothers and sisters. In fact living here all alone, apart from my community, has impressed on me more than ever the importance of my religious “family”.

I am presently preparing two young couples for marriage. One will be married at OLS in January and the other in the Latin Mass community also in January. The two couples are very different but both are filled with hope. They seem to believe in the future because they believe in one another and the life that God has called them to form together. In the sacrament of marriage it's not just a man and woman who are doing something. The prime actor is God who is making two individuals a new creation. When a man and a woman marry they are called by God not just to be husband and wife but father and mother. They create not just a couple but they begin a family.

In talks during his visit, Pope Francis recognized the gift and the difficulty of being family today. On several occasions the Holy Father has spoken about the need for ways to support families. One such way, a very simple one, is called the Enthronement of the Sacred Heart in the Home. The Enthronement involves placing an image of Jesus, showing his loving heart, in a place of honor in the home. By that action and the accompanying words, the family declares that Jesus is the King and center of their life. Families who have had the Enthronement tell of wonders of grace that happen as a result.

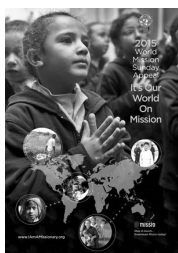

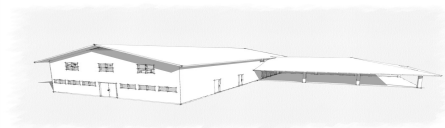

New Parish Hall & OLS Capital Campaign

Our Forward in Faith Campaign continues toward our goal to raise \$1.5 million for new restrooms, a Parish Hall, and much needed upgrades to the Church. We thank our 391 fellow Parishioners, Families, and Businesses for the \$805,861 in pledges.

As we have mentioned, we will be sending out letters and pledge forms to over 300 commercial businesses in Wahiawa by mid-October. If you have an acquaintance with a business owner, you can help our campaign by asking if they received the letter and would consider a donation.
