40 Days for Life is a focused pro-life campaign with a vision to end abortion through prayer, fasting, and peaceful vigil, with the purpose of repentance, to seek God's favor to turn hearts and minds from a culture of death to a culture of life, thus bringing an end to abortion.

During this 40 Days for Life campaign we, too, fast to reject the sin of abortion and in prayer to unite ourselves with the Lord of Life who is working through us to end abortion.

Prayer and Fasting: Fasting provides a powerful opportunity for us to reject sin and to intensify our prayer. Jesus told us that some issues can only be dealt with by prayer and fasting. We are praying that God's loving kindness will be evident to those who turn to abortion; that they might choose life.

Constant Vigil: The most visible aspect of 40 Days for Life is peaceful prayer, outside abortion facilities. We are friendly witnesses for life, because the shaking finger never helps.

The goal is to have constant prayer during the 40 day vigil, 12 hours a day, 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM for 40 days.

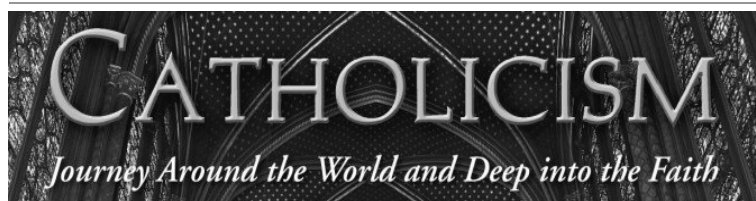

Episode 9: "The Life of His Love: Prayer and the Life of the Spirit"

September 27, 2015 at 10:30 AM (Library)

Join the Catholic Café as we continue the *Catholicism* series by Fr. Robert Barron. In Episode 9, Father Barron explores Catholic spirituality, which is centered on prayer. As the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* states: "Prayer is the lifting up of the mind and the heart to God." On pilgrimage to the places where the great saints and spiritual masters lived, Father Barron explores the different types of prayer: contemplation; adoration; petition; and intercession. In telling the stories of Catholics like Thomas Merton, St. Theresa of Avila and St. John of the Cross, Fr. Barron demonstrates how the human person can be transformed through prayer that manifests a deep, spiritual commitment centered in Christ.
