**MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD**

“The pastoral council is the pastor’s advisory and consultative body in the parish...“The primary responsibility of the pastoral Council is pastoral planning. The members prayerfully investigate and ponder issues of concern to the whole community and make recommendations to the pastor for goals and actions.” (Guidelines for Parish Pastoral Councils, p. 9 and 14) Those goals and actions take the form of a “Pastoral Plan” for our parish. The plan is meant to help the parish fulfill its mission and hopefully grow. This year we will be updating the plan in preparation for Bishop Larry’s episcopal visit at the end of August 2016.

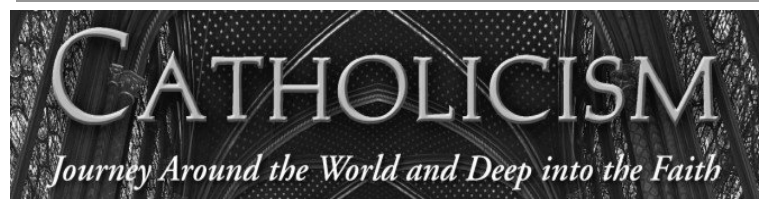

Episode 9: "The Life of His Love: Prayer and the Life of the Spirit"

September 27, 2015 at 10:30 AM (Library)

Join the Catholic Café as we continue the *Catholicism* series by Fr. Robert Barron. In Episode 9, Father Barron explores Catholic spirituality, which is centered on prayer. As the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* states: "Prayer is the lifting up of the mind and the heart to God." On pilgrimage to the places where the great saints and spiritual masters lived, Father Barron explores the different types of prayer: contemplation; adoration; petition; and intercession. In telling the stories of Catholics like Thomas Merton, St. Theresa of Avila and St. John of the Cross, Fr. Barron demonstrates how the human person can be transformed through prayer that manifests a deep, spiritual commitment centered in Christ.

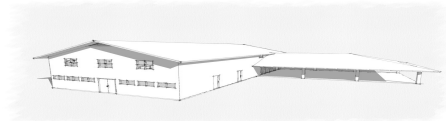
