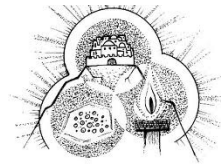

### MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

When I arrived at Our Lady of Sorrows a year ago, Father Clyde told me of the project to build a new parish hall. That's been on the books for some time and we have to get to it.

Our Architect (Structural Hawaii) is presently drawing the plans. They are projecting a cost of \$1.2 million. It will include ADA complaint bathrooms that will be accessible to the Church, a kitchen and storage areas. In order to get approval for the diocese for construction we have to have 50% of the cost on hand. At present we have just over \$300,000 in our building fund.

Our Church also badly needs some work on the sound system and electrical wiring. We also want to adapt the sanctuary so it is better suited for the celebration of the liturgy. If we add that and furnishings for the new hall, we need to raise a total of \$1.5 million.

I believe that OLS has a bright future. We will grow if we look outward, do the Lord's work of spreading the Gospel and call young and old to follow him with us. As we look to the future we will need suitable places for the community to gather. The most important of those, of course, is the Church, where we celebrate the mysteries of Christ. In our new hall, we will gather to strengthen the bonds among us and celebrate all that God has given us.

In order to reach our goal of \$1.5 million, we will begin a capital campaign in the near future. At present we are organizing the campaign committee. Soon we hope to have a scale model and architectural drawings of the new hall on display in the Church so that everyone can see what we hope to build.

Quite honestly this all seems a bit daunting to me but then I remember I am only one person. We are in this together and, most especially, the Lord is with us.

## **A Reminder from the Diocese....**

### **Winter Cold and Flu Season**

As always, you are reminded to use common sense in the reception of Holy Communion from the chalice during the annual cold and flu season. If you are feeling ill or think you may have been exposed to a virus, you should refrain from partaking of the Blood of Christ from the communal chalice. In the same way, you should refrain from offering your hand to others at the sign of peace. A smile and a heartfelt "Peace be with you" should suffice. Likewise if you are not comfortable sharing the sign of peace or receiving Holy Communion from the communal chalice for fear of infection, you should feel no pressure to do so. All of us must be aware of such sensitive matters in the intimate life of the Christian community and we should expect that some will refrain from the sign of peace and the communal chalice out of care for our well-being and not out of unkindness or a lack of piety.

### **Liturgy and Illness**

Please be aware that the obligation to attend Sunday Mass does not apply to those who are ill, especially those who suffer from contagious disease. It is a sign of consideration for oneself and others that those with flu-like symptoms remain at home.
