Year of Mercy

Family Resources from the US Conference of Catholic Bishops

Last week we gave you suggestions to help you and your family celebrate the Year of Mercy. The third suggestion asked our families to learn the corporal and spiritual works of mercy. Beginning in this bulletin we will provide you with information from the USCCB on suggestions for the corporal and spiritual works of mercy.

The Corporal Works of Mercy

The Corporal Works of Mercy are found in the teachings of Jesus and give us a model for how we should treat all others, as if they were Christ in disguise. They "are charitable actions by which we help our neighbors in their bodily needs" (US Catholic Catechism for Adults). They respond to the basic needs of humanity as we journey together through this life.

There are seven Corporal Works of Mercy-Feed the Hungry, Give Drink to the Thirsty, Shelter the Homeless, Visit the Sick, Visit the Prisoners, Bury the Dead, and Give Alms to the Poor. After each work of mercy there are also suggestions and words of advice for living them out in our daily lives.

FEED THE HUNGRY.

There are many people in this world who go without food. When so much of our food goes to waste, consider how good stewardship practices of your own food habits can benefit others who do not have those same resources.

- Having delicious food at Thanksgiving or Christmas dinner? Donate to a Thanksgiving or Christmas food drive so everyone can have something to eat.
- Research, identify and contribute financially to organizations that serve the hungry.
- The next time you make a recipe that can be easily frozen, make a double batch and donate one to your local food pantry or soup kitchen.
- Try not to purchase more food than you are able to eat. If you notice that you end up throwing groceries away each week, purchasing less groceries would eliminate waste and allow you to donate the savings to those in need.
