Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Fr. Ajith is settling in. Thank you, everyone, for welcoming him and making him feel at home. As you know, he and I are members of the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts. It's an odd that we live alone because our rule calls for us to live with other ss.cc.'s in a community. So it's good being together in the rectory, if only just for two months. We pray together, have meals together and support one another.

One of the reasons that Father came two months before he takes over as Pastor on September 1 was to get up to speed on some of the rather large projects on our OLS agenda. One, of course, is the new hall and bathrooms. As I said last weekend the permit application is slowly moving through the different offices downtown. It's slow but there is movement.

Our *Forward in Faith Campaign* continues so that we can pay for the hall. We so appreciate those who have made pledges and are faithfully paying them off. Thanks also to the team that organizes our semi-monthly sale on the lanai and thanks to all of our parishioners who are so supportive. Last week's sale brought in \$1966. May the Lord bless your generosity.

As I wrote some months back, the Kamilani Academy, a kindergarten to grade 8 charter school wants to lease our school building but first they have to receive approval from the state as a charter school. Preliminary indications seem positive. A final decision will be made this month. If the state gives the go ahead, that will bring in much needed income to support our parish ministries.

Next weekend Bishop Larry will be with us for his Episcopal Visit. It's always a grace when the Bishop visits as he is the first Pastor of the Diocese. He will celebrate and preach at the three Masses. On Saturday evening he will meet with the parish leadership. After the 9:00 Mass there will be a "town hall meeting" to which everyone is invited. After that he will meet with our parish youth. May God bless our Bishop's visit among us.
