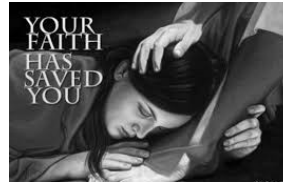

MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As you know, this weekend the second collection is for the missions of the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts, the religious order of which I am a member. European missionaries of our community brought the Catholic faith to Hawaii in 1827. Now missionaries from our USA province go on mission to India, Tonga and Fiji. You can read more about our missions in the flier included in this weekend's bulletin. Thank you, in advance, for your support.

In different ways OLS parishioners regularly give a portion of their financial resources for the Church's mission. You give to the regular collection that allows us to function as a parish and pay our bills. At least one Sunday a month there is a second collection for some special need identified by the Church (e.g. communications, the Church in Latin America). Many of you have already made a gift or a pledge to the Forward in Faith campaign that will allow us to build our new hall and bathrooms.

Material resources are gifts of which we are asked to be good stewards. One may think that being a good steward of our "treasure" means protecting it and assuring it increases so that our financial security is more solidly assured. In terms of the Gospel of Jesus, a good steward is one who shares what they have in thanksgiving to God. Christian stewardship means giving away, letting go of a portion of our finances to make God's work possible. Stewardship means not giving what is left over after I've paid for everything else but deciding beforehand what portion of my income I will give and dedicating it to God every month.

Thank you for being so generous with your financial resources. Our parish can do so much because our parishioners already practice Christian stewardship.

The Diocese of Honolulu is committed to creating and maintaining the safest environment possible for our youth when they are in our care. Our Safe Environment policies, governed by the mandates of the U.S. Conference of Bishops' *Charter for the Protection of Children and Youth*, outline standards to: provide an effective response to allegations of sexual abuse, call for more effective screening of those entering service in the Church, and provide for training for clergy and others (i.e. lay employees and volunteers) who have contact with minors or who are in a position of trust in the Church.

The annual audit report was due in May and we are pleased to report that all OLS staff and volunteers have completed the necessary safe environment and background checks required to work with the youth of our parish.
