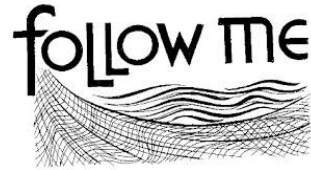

MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

We often speak of stewardship. God has given us so many gifts. He calls us to care for his gifts as good stewards. The best way we care for God's gifts is by sharing them. We find that God's gift to us is not diminished by sharing it but increased by God's grace.

In 1 Corinthians 12, St. Paul mentions many different gifts: wisdom, knowledge, faith, healing, mighty deeds, prophecy, tongues, to name but a few. Paul did not mean to give a complete list of all gifts! At the very end of the chapter he says "But I shall show you a still more excellent way." Then he spends chapter 13 speaking about the "gift of gifts" – love. Generous, self-giving love is the great gift because it makes us most like God. "Whoever does not love, does not know God, because God is love." (1 John 4:8)

Last Sunday our country suffered what President Obama rightly called "an act of terror and hate." I don't envy the President and whoever succeeds him (President Trump? President Clinton?). They face very difficult choices in confronting the hatred and violence abroad in our world.

And what do we do in face of it? Certainly we have to participate in the political process and vote, doing so based on the best information that we have. However that is not all. There is something more immediate.

As members of the body of Christ, we live by his Holy Spirit. He dwells within us. We have received the gift of gift, his love. Right where we are, in our everyday relationships, being good stewards of that great gift, we share it: when we forgive even what may seem unforgivable, when we make the effort to understand someone very different than us, when we catch our critical tongue and give someone the benefit of the doubt.

Pope Paul VI wrote, "Peace is built up every day by acts of peace." The peace he spoke of is fruit of the Lord's love given us as gift. Let us recommit to being good stewards of that gift.

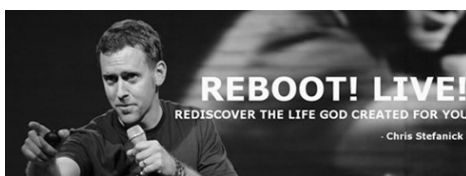
HOLY FATHER / PETER'S PENCE COLLECTION

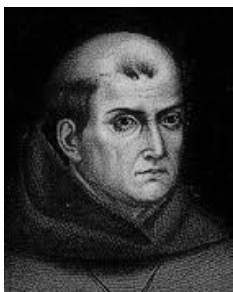
