**MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD**

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

On Friday, July 1, our parish will welcome Fr. Ajith Antony Dass, ss.cc. Father Ajith will spend July and August with me preparing to assume the Pastorate of OLS on September 1. These two months will give him an opportunity to meet parishioners, to work with the Pastoral Staff preparing for activities beginning in August and have a first experience of the Pastoral Council, Finance Committee, Stewardship, Development and other parish groups. Father will participate in Bishop Larry's Episcopal Visit July 16-17. These months will also be an opportunity to get up to speed on the hall construction project as well as the plan to lease our school to the Kamalani Charter School.

Fr. Ajith was born in 1974 in Chennai in the state of Tamil Nadu on the southeastern coast of India. He made his first vows in the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts in 2001 and was ordained to the Priesthood in 2006. He has been in Hawaii for almost two years working as Parochial Vicar at St. Ann's Kaneohe. Before that he was Superior of our ss.cc. formation community outside Kolkata, India. He also taught Theology and Philosophy at the Morning Star Major Seminary in Kolkata. Fr. Ajith and I lived together in Rome 2010-2012 during my last two years on our leadership team, while he was doing a graduate degree in theology.



Father brings many gifts to our parish. His gifts become a greater blessing if they are joined to everyone else at OLS' gifts. "We are the Spirit-filled Body of Christ", as our logo says. Being here has given me a deeper awareness and understanding of being "priest". I pray that will be the same for Fr. Ajith.

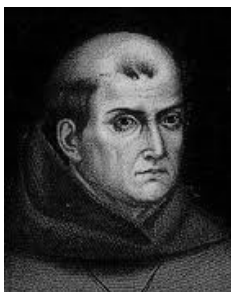
