## MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Once I heard a preacher say that as Christians we should develop "an attitude of gratitude." It's a catchy turn of phrase but there's some wisdom there.

Our faith can become heavy or depressing because we can focus too much on what we don't have (my sin and imperfection or what God has not given me) rather than on the gifts we do have. There are material gifts (adequate food, shelter, medical care), intellectual gifts (the ability to think, read, learn), emotional gifts (the love and support of family, friends, community) and spiritual gifts (prayer, the sacraments, Scripture, my ministry to the community) and that's just a few of the ones we could mention.

None of those gifts do I create myself. They all come from God, Father Son and Spirit, the great giver of gifts. These gifts are entrusted to us to be cared for, to be used in service of God and others and ultimately to be returned to God in thanksgiving.

Writing to the Corinthians, Saint Paul told them, "Thus should one regard us: as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God." (1 Cor. 4:1) We are stewards of God's gifts, his simple everyday ones and his deep mysteries.

OLS is such a gifted community. Absolutely every member of our parish has received gifts from God. Every man, woman and child, from the very young to the very old, from the most active to those slowed down by age and infirmity has some gift given by God. Each of us is called to be a steward of that gift and with "an attitude of gratitude" offer the gift in thanks to God.
