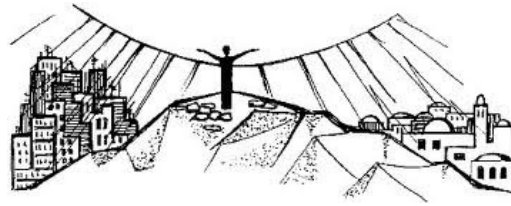

MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This week Yahoo had an article on Pope Francis and how he's supposedly ready to change some Church doctrine that Yahoo considers "outdated." The accompanying photo of the Pope had a halo around his head. It's a particularly egregious example of many in the media's misunderstanding of the Pope.

It would surprise Yahoo and others how often the Pope speaks of the devil, temptation and sin. I just googled "Pope Francis and Temptation" and there was reference upon reference to his words on the topic. Why should that be so surprising? "Is the Pope Catholic?" He most certainly is.

Today in the Gospel we hear of Jesus being tempted. One commentator said it would be a more accurate translation to say that the devil "tested" him.

Before Jesus set out on the mission given by his Father, the evil one tried his darnedest to pervert him. Should we be surprised that we are tested? Pope Francis speaks of temptation not in the abstract but of his own experience of being tried by the evil one. Each one of us could do the same.

We continue Jesus' mission. We are to bring Jesus, the Son of God and only savior, to those who need him. That's absolutely everyone. We are on Jesus' mission here in Wahiawa. If the Master was tested, so will we be. The devil wants nothing more than to turn us from the Lord and destroy us.

If he can't get us by outright sin, he'll try to discourage or divide us.

But to God is the victory. As Saint Paul reminds us, "the grace of God and the gracious gift of the one man Jesus Christ overflow." The devil has nothing on Jesus.
