MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

Today we begin "Holy" Week and we could ask why this week is any holier than the other fifty-one weeks of the year. We would be mistaken to think it holy because it's sort of an anniversary of the death and resurrection of Jesus. True Jesus really died and rose at one point in history but Holy Week is more than just remembering a past event.

This year we proclaim Saint Luke's account of Our Lord's passion. We also hear Saint Paul's beautiful hymn from the letter to the Philippians that gives a clue to the deeper meaning of Jesus' suffering. Jesus, the Son of God, "emptied himself." God's Son became our servant to free us from sin and to baptize us in his Spirit so that Jesus really is our "Lord", the center and motivating force of our life. Jesus dies on the cross to reconcile us to the Father and allow us, through Him, to give the father perfect praise and loving obedience.

The Lenten season ends on Thursday evening and the Mass of the Lord's Supper begins the Easter Triduum. A triduum is three days. It takes us three days, from Thursday evening to evening prayer on Easter Sunday to adequately celebrate the great gift of God, which is life in Jesus Christ. Let us pray for one another that we will have open hearts to receive the grace of this time.
