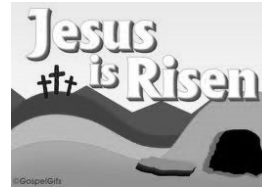

**MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD**

Blessed Easter to one and all!

On Palm Sunday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil, the liturgy tells the priest or deacon to give a "brief homily." Given the length of the Scripture readings, a brief homily is a merciful choice. From another perspective, it's difficult for a preacher to find all that much to say. The mystery we celebrate in these days is what our faith is all about. It's what we celebrate and preach about every day of the year. Not just the Eucharist but all the sacraments are a celebration of the dying and rising of Jesus and the mystery's power to transform our lives from the inside out. In fact, if the liturgy of these days is well celebrated there is almost no need for a homily.

When we get to heaven and see God, we will see the most beautiful being imaginable. God is beauty itself. Just now I showed someone our church and he remarked how beautiful it was. I often think that the beauty of our church is only surpassed by the beauty of the community that calls this church theirs. Since God is beauty when we gather for liturgy our worship of God must be beautiful. You all contribute to that beauty: our attentive and participative worshiping community, our liturgy office and our Coordinators, Kainoa and Rani, our faithful Deacons Dino and Ben, our music ministry, choirs and instrumentalists, our ministers of ceremony and sacristans, readers and commentators, Extraordinary Ministers of Communion, our faithful altar servers, our hospitality ministers and ushers and our decorators. Thank you!

And thank you, Lord, for allowing us to celebrate your death and rising all through the year and for the gifts that the community brings to our liturgical celebrations.

### The Spiritual Works of Mercy

The Spiritual Works of Mercy have long been a part of the Christian tradition, appearing in the works of theologians and spiritual writers throughout history. Just as Jesus attended to the spiritual well-being of those he ministered to, these Spiritual Works of Mercy guide us to "help our neighbor in their spiritual needs" (US Catholic Catechism for Adults).

The seven Spiritual Works of Mercy are Counseling the Doubtful, Instructing the Ignorant, Admonishing the Sinner, Comforting the Sorrowful, Forgiving Injuries, Bearing Wrongs Patiently and Praying for the Living and the Dead.



### COUNSELING THE DOUBTFUL.

Everyone has moments of doubt in their faith journey. Nevertheless, we should always remember that Christ is the Way, the Truth, and the Life and turn to him along our way.

- Listen to counsel and receive instruction, "that you may eventually become wise" (Proverbs 19:20)
- The Cross of Christ "the foolishness of God is wiser than human wisdom, and the weakness of God is stronger than human strength" (1 Cor 1:25)
- Has someone asked you for advice? Orient your response to Christ, who is the Way, the Truth, and the Life
- Follow Christ with the witness of your life so that others may see God's love revealed in your actions
- Accompany a friend who is struggling with believing to join a parish group for service or faith formation, share a book you found useful in dealing with your friend's faith concern, and worship at Sunday Mass
