MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The Gospel these Sundays before the feast of the Ascension is taken from Jesus' talk to his Apostles at the Last Supper. He speaks about "going away". Those words have struck me because of that I want to tell you at this time.

My Provincial Superior, Father Johnathan Hurrell ss.cc. has asked me to become the Superior of our house of formation (seminary community) in Fiji. This means that I will be leaving OLS on September 1. The new pastor will be Father Antony Dass ss.cc., presently parochial Vicar at St. Ann's in Kaneohe.

Given all the things happening right now in our parish (e.g. construction of the new hall and bathrooms) Fr. Antony will arrive on July 1 and spend July and August with me learning the ropes.

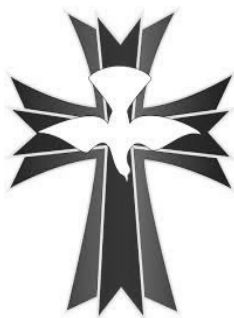
I have known Fr. Antony for some years. He will bring many gifts to OLS. We lived together in Rome for two years when I was on our leadership team and he was doing graduate studies. He is intelligent and personable and he has the energy of a man twenty-five years younger than I!

This new assignment is not something I sought or expected. Almost four years ago, the Provincial called me in Rome and asked me to come to OLS as Pastor. Now he has asked me to go to Fiji. Forty-eight years ago I made a vow of obedience. My experience tells me that the Church is most blessed when I do what the Lord asks through my superiors than what I might think is best.

We often speak about the lack of vocations to religious life and the priesthood. With thanks to God, our ss.cc. community is experiencing a new inflow of vocations. There are presently seven young brothers in the Fiji community. Next year there may be as many as eleven. So perhaps I will contribute to the formation of a young man who will one day come to OLS as a priest.

Again, I will be here until September 1. Fr. Antony will arrive on July 1 to ready himself to assume the pastorate on September 1. You are always in my prayer. I ask a remembrance in yours.
