THE DEDICATION OF THE LATERAN BASILICA

Weekend of November 8-9, 2014



MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Off the bat it's hard to understand why the feast of "The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica" bumps the 32nd Sunday in ordinary time. What's so great about the Lateran Basilica? What, in God's name, even is the Lateran Basilica?

The Basilica of St. John Lateran is the Cathedral of the Diocese of Rome. Therefore, it's the Pope's Cathedral because the Pope is the Bishop of Rome. At Mass in Rome when we pray for our Pope...and our Bishop..., we say "for our Pope and Bishop Francis."

So to celebrate the dedication of the Pope's cathedral is to be reminded that our Church is big, extremely big. We mention the Bishop's name in every Mass because we are part of a diocese, the Church of Honolulu, and Bishop Larry is our pastor. I'm his vicar for OLS Wahiawa. We mention the Pope's name before the Bishop's because OLS is not just part of a state-wide diocese but a community of the universal or "Catholic" Church. We are one with communities gathered around their bishops and priests all over the globe "from the rising of the sun to its setting..."

The Church is not only extended geographically but also historically. In one of the other great basilicas of Rome, St. Paul outside the Walls, there are mosaics of all 266 Popes down to Pope Francis. As Pope Benedict XVI wisely reminded us, the Pope is not an absolute monarch. He can't do just anything he pleases. For example, the Pope cannot change the teaching of the Church (There's been much speculation about this in recent weeks given the discussions in Rome about marriage and sexuality). The Pope is a servant of the truth of Jesus Christ and he must teach God's Word in continuity with the Church throughout the ages and with his 265 predecessors. As such he guarantees that we remain in the truth of Jesus Christ. What a great assurance and another reason to celebrate a feast that unites us to our Holy Father, the Pope, the Bishop of Rome.

We offer our time and talent to the Lord in thanksgiving for it all comes from God. We offer it back to Him and he increases the blessing a hundredfold. The more we practice good stewardship of God's gifts the stronger we become as OLS and as individual disciples of Jesus Christ.
