### MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD

I am not with you this weekend as I am in Orlando, Florida. Now that is the home of Disney World and the Epcot Center but I can assure you that I will not be anywhere near them. The Annual Conference of the International Catholic Stewardship Council is taking place in Orlando and I'm part of the delegation from the Diocese of Honolulu. I left on Friday evening and will return on Wednesday.

Bishop Larry is calling the whole diocese to adopt Stewardship as the way we live and do things. OK, what does that mean? I'm not too sure. That's why I was delighted when Mark Clark, the Diocesan Director of Stewardship, asked me to go with 20 others to the conference. It's a unique opportunity to learn so much of value I can then bring back to OLS. The conference is organized in four different tracks according to experience with stewardship. Needless to say, I'm at the basic level. Over the years to come our whole diocese and we here at OLS will be learning about stewardship together.

The basic text about Catholic Stewardship in the USA is a letter written by the US Bishops in 2001 entitled "Stewardship: a Disciple's Response." They ask, "Who is a Christian steward?" The response, "One who receives God's gifts gratefully, cherishes and tends them in a responsible and accountable manner, shares them in justice and love with others, and returns them with increase to the Lord." Stewardship is not another program but a way of understanding our call to follow Jesus and to be his Spirit-filled body. Pray that it all sinks in and that I return safely.

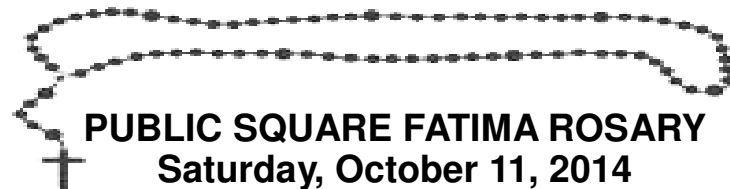
