**MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD**

Often when I am making adoration of the Blessed Sacrament the closing words of the Eucharistic Prayer come to mind, "Through him and with him and in him, O God almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honor is yours forever and ever."

Holy Mass is our great prayer of praise and adoration. We praise our loving Father through, with and in Jesus and we are able to do that because the Holy Spirit is within us. Jesus' greatest act of praise and love for his Father was his death on the cross. At Mass through the power of the Holy Spirit we are united to Jesus' sacrifice on the cross, sacramentally present on the altar. We join Jesus in his love and praise for the Father. There is no greater way to adore and praise God than in the Eucharist.

After Mass the Lord Jesus remains present among us in the Blessed Sacrament. The tabernacle in every Catholic Church contains the second person of the Trinity, Jesus Christ. The traditional formula says that he is present "body and blood, soul and divinity." It's really Him. It is the Lord. The adoration that begins at Mass can continue every time we come into Jesus' presence.

When we come into Church we adore the Father with Jesus and we adore Jesus. To adore Jesus is to tell him of our love. We thank him for the many blessings big and small that come from him every day. In light of his boundless love, we realize how small and sinful we can be and we ask for his forgiveness and mercy. Then there are all the many needs and problems of everyday that we bring to him. There is always something to say to Jesus. Arrive before Mass and spend time with him. Linger after Mass and speak to him. Every day the cry room is open so that we can visit Our Lord and adore him.

Next weekend when you come to Mass you will notice an important change in the sanctuary of our Church. The tabernacle containing the Blessed Sacrament, the Body of Jesus Christ, will be moved from the side altar to the center under the crucifix.

We are the Body of Christ. His Spirit fills us, anointing us to do Jesus' work. Jesus is the center, the reason for which we exist. May we be reminded of that every time we come into our Church and when we go forth take him with us to share along the way.
